

Former Taft College Superintendent/ President and Emcee Willy Duncan expertly navigated everyone through fond memories of his long friendship and working with Brock. The Taft College TIL Program may use the more than \$33,000 raised that night to purchase an ADA-compliant vehicle to transport two wheelchairs along with students and staff.
