"Here in Kern County, we're definitely seeing a rise in all three. So that's COVID, flu, and flu more than anything just because it affects all different age groups," said Dr. Vithalani, who works at Kaiser Permanente, Kern County.

"We're definitely seeing a surge right now. Especially after the holidays," she continues.

The big three sicknesses right now are the flu, RSV, and COVID-19, and they all start with a cough, runny nose, and a fever.

Although surges like the one the state is facing now is common after many have returned to close quarters, these illnesses don't just go away once winter ends.

"COVID and RSV can last all year long, but we do still see it around the same time every year."

Flu season peaks from December to February, and can even continue on until March.

I also spoke with Nicole Henry, the district leader with CVS Health and doctor of public health. She says a big way to make sure you stay healthy, and out of the hospital, is to get vaccinated.

"It's very important to make sure our patients are protected with immunizations

"The COVID vaccination, it's actually an updated version of the COVID vaccine. So those that have not had a COVID vaccine in the past two months," she continued.

Along with the COVID-19 vaccine, you can also receive an RSV vaccine if you're pregnant and course, there's always the flu shot.

"It's both 60% to 70% effective to prevent that flu illness in patients all together. So those complications. So patients don't end up hospitalized or have any complications.

And for those that believe the flu shot makes you sick, Henry said that's just a myth.

"It's an inactivated vaccine. So we can absolutely not get the flu from the inactivated. It's a killed portion of the virus, so it's not going to give anybody the flu. What they need

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People can get all three vaccines at once, and in addition to getting vaccinated, regular exercise, social distancing and using masks when appropriate can all help

And while [California is facing a surge in flu](#) and Kern County has seen hundreds of cases in a couple of months, all because you caught one bug, doesn't mean you can't catch another.

"People can also have one or more infections. At the same time. So somebody could catch two at the same time, so it's just something to watch out for," said Vithalani.

If you are looking to get vaccinated, it's not too late. You can always check in with your doctor or pharmacy to see what vaccines are available for you to receive.



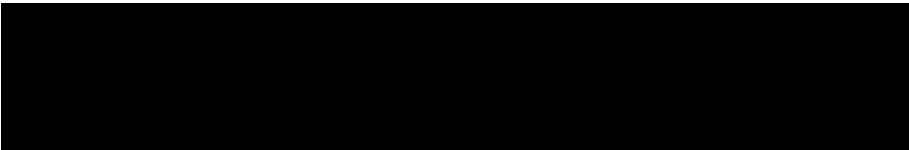
